POLITICAL PHILOSOPHY.

C.C.U shall pursue the philosophy of separation of state and religion. Since, no one can separate the state from God, and submission to God goes along with being respectful and cognisant of the rights of fellow human beings.

WHY DO WE FORM A GOVERNMENT?

We form a government so that we can have an organised administration for the Nation state interest for the well being of all its citizens.

WHY IS IT NECESSARY TO VOTE?

We vote because it is mandatory to secure representation in the executive arm of the government (Presidency, National Assembly and Local Government) that creates laws and determines the expropriation of taxes.

WHAT IS A POLITICAL PARTY?

A political party is an (political) organisation that subscribes to certain ideologies and seeks to attain political power in a country to form the government. The party's policy often represents an aggregation of interests and ideas within the party, which will inevitably, at times, vary considerably even between party members, but are manifested to be the party manifesto.

WHAT IS A GOOD POLITICAL PARTY?

A good political party is that which lives up to its established ideals and policies, that reaches the aspirations of the majority and safe guards the interests of the minority groups.

WHICH IS THIS PARTY

The Party is Chama cha Uzalendo which prescribes to the ideology of SOCIAL DEMOCRACY that upholds descent free market economic policies.

SOCIAL DEMOCRACY .

WHAT IS SOCIAL DEMOCRACY

Social democracy refers to a broad array of doctrines or political movements that envisage a socio-economic system in which property and the distribution of wealth are subject to social control. This control may either be direct- exercised through popular collectives such as POLITICAL PARTY- or it may be indirect - exercised on behalf of the people by the state. As an economic system, socialism is often associated with state, community or worker ownership of the means of production but also serves as the society's vanguard against exploitation.

WHO BENEFITS?

The Able and the Disabled, the rich and the poor, the weak and the strong, the majority and the minority, men and women; THE WHOLE SOCIETY.

WHO RUNS THINGS?

In a Social Democracy, the people together with their leaders plan, run, implement, execute actions through a democratically elected government.

DEMOCRATIC CONTROL

All persons elected to any post in the social democratic structure, from the lowest to the highest level, will be directly accountable to the rank and file. They will be subjected to removal at any time when the majority of those who elected them decide it is necessary. Such a system would make possible the fullest democracy and freedom.

INDIVIDUAL RIGHTS

For individuals, social democracy means a chance to develop all individual capacities and potentials within a free community of free individuals. It means a classless society that guarantees full democratic rights for all people

SOCIAL DEMOCRACY IS NOT AS POPULARLY PERCEIVED:-

- >Social democracy does not mean government or state ownership.
- >It does not mean a closed party-run system without democratic rights.

- > It does not mean “nationalization” or “labour management boards,” or state capitalism of any kind.
- > It means a government of the people by the people for the people.

HAS SOCIAL DEMOCRACY EVER BEEN TRIED BEFORE?

Yes! Social democracy has been tried and is in use in many successful countries of the world today. Even the so called capitalist states have had to adhere to some socialist policies domestically in order to achieve their socio-economic and political stability, prime example being the Scandinavian countries, (Sweden, Norway and Denmark) European powers, ranging from Spain, France, Britain and Germany. The world is also witnessing the mighty china toning down from far left (communism) to centre left (social democracy) where as, the stability that has seen India rising up as a world power emanates from utilization of this ideology hence the status of the WORLD'S LARGEST DEMOCRACY. The political maturity and patriotism witnessed in Tanzania is as a result of utilizing social democracy. Latin America is currently in pursuit of adapting the same ideology for it's socio-economic and political endeavours. Why not Africa and Kenya?

POLITICS

The Politics of this country have ceased having the glare they were expected to nurture as from the time we attained our independence, having started with confrontational rebellious politics against the colonial administration. Our country has seen itself degenerating into a more backward form of politics which started of as racialistic but now has degenerated to tribal and soon will be clan based if we are to see the end results of the current district's halving initiatives.

However, the new generation of KENYA is on its own integrating very fast, but the command of large sphere of influence by the old generation which has been blind to these developments, has led to the majority of citizens being highly disoriented due to factors like nepotism.

The old political generation dominance and resistance to handover in politics has turned around to be the greatest set back this country is suffering from. Unfortunately, their much taunted wisdom, has clearly been demonstrated as experience and wisdom of manipulating the country for their own selfish interests and not for the so called tribes or “watu wao” who more often they exploit. Unlike other African countries, Kenyans have, to some degree, lived up to see the fruits of the much-taunted independence but have not yet enjoyed them collectively.



We fought for independence as “watu weusi” (Black people) against “watu weupe” (White People) but we have lived in freedom as “Wakikuyu, Wajaluo, Waswahili, Wahindi, e.t.c. This demonstrates that our war was not built on convictions but by prejudice and irrationalism. The saddest thing to note is the arrival of political pluralism in the country, it came at a time when the country was suffering from a leadership famine since the crop of politicians available at that time were either tired, aged, frustrated and some were not mature enough politically to see anything beyond their tribes to see KENYA as a whole, or to make any efforts in placing the necessary frame work for the thriving of pluralism. The leadership of the first government wasted no time to develop the citizens into prospective leaders but instead, opted to frustrate and destroy any promising ones out of its circle but did place an infrastructure for their kin and kith to grow so that they can reign.

The second phase government became the protector of the same manoeuvres while the third phase government, the best it can do is to recycle politicians and accord more room to activists turned politicians into the reign of responsibility.

They say you can never teach an old dog new tricks. Those are the English words, but Swahili asserts that, “mwenda wazimu haponi bali hupata nafuu pekee,” Chama Cha Uzalendo says, enough is enough, let us divorce the past and put a break to tribal politics and parties since not any time a Kikuyu shall succeed in converting a Luo to be Kikuyu neither vice versa but unless they marry to be one and that is what social democracy is.

Chama Cha Uzalendo humbly invites you to a party that wishes to uphold politics of nationalism; politics built on practical policies that you, as a citizen shall stand to benefit. We in C.C.U. believe that, a well-trained doctor can just treat patients for money but a patriotic doctor can heal the nation. Therefore, C.C.U. invites you to a party that shall at all times be bound by principles of good governance, social justice and solidarity, a party that shall be a vehicle of your prosperity and a true defender of our national integrity.

CENTRAL TASK OF C.C.U GOVERNMENT.

Each phase of government has had its own declared central tasks e.g. “Uhuru na Kazi,” along with African empowerment Sessional paper No 10 (Kenyatta) ignorance, tribalism and the Nyayo philosophy of “Peace Love and Unity” (Moi) then, fighting corruption and revival of the economy, hence the working Nation (Kibaki). Unfortunately, most of these promised endeavours have only ended up to be hot air and empty rhetoric only used for the sole purpose of getting into office to be celebrated but NOT to serve the nation.

This started with the clarion call for agitation of independence, “Mzungu Arudi Ulaya Mwafrika Apate uhuru” (MAU MAU) but the big question is; did the Mzungu actually go back to Ulaya (Europe)? Did Mwafrika ever get Uhuru (independence)? if he did, why then is he not manufacturing his own toothbrush, his towels, his sandals; his most basic requirements? Did we fight for independence purposely for changing bad administration or the colour of the administrator?, was it wise to change white exploiter with a black exploiter? If the principal need for independence agitation was the colour of the skin, then it must have been a useless effort that leaves us without any doubt that the citizens of this country have not attained the desired independence and freedom from bad governance and exploitative policies.

The colonizers could not instil any sense of Nationhood in us since it could have worked against their designs, hence their culture of divide and rule which later became very handy for the so-called independent heroes and their cronies who are the later day second and third liberation heroes.

CCU's central task shall be to nurture a society in which all citizens have a sense of belonging and one in which no form of discrimination or marginalization is tolerated. We will in our government make sure that power is devolved from the centre to the people where it belongs in order to create an all inclusive culture in managing national affairs

NATIONAL UNITY.

National unity is important for stability, whereas Kenyans treasure all these attributes, they have not been getting well established parties with focused leadership that is geared towards fuelling the nation with the much needed ingredient of National cohesiveness .

Chama Cha Uzalendo and its presidential candidate wishes to take the onus of stimulating Kenyans to think first as Kenyans before they settle into any tribal or racial inclination. This shall largely be done by illegalising tribalism by law and frustrating tribally based organisations, associations, welfare organisations, social groupings and enterprises by encouraging ideologically and multilaterally based setups that do not discredit any person by virtue of tribe, clan, religion, creed or race unless it be a formally recognized, and is working within acceptable norms of the society.

Chama Cha Uzalendo has realized that, if nothing is done, then there is great fear that some individuals are hell bent to take us a back by maintaining the current status quo so that we can persist in seeing ourselves as members of tribes other than Kenyans. Chama Cha Uzalendo will ensure that its entire candidates including its presidential candidate shall not use discrimination as leverage to power; this shall not be tolerated and we shall not allow it since it has been a tool for dividing our country.

CCU will embark on a national campaign to instill national unity and also ensure that money in politics remains only an aspect of logistics but not as a weapon to purchase people's consciousness and their social democratic rights, since that is a form of prejudice of those who have against those who don't have. The party shall be strict on all its aspirants for elective positions from the president, national assembly and the local government. The party shall not tolerate any devious ways of raising funds by its candidates or the use of it to exert undue influence on others. The party will ensure that politics remain politics but not business hidden in politics which results in the compromise of public service delivery.

Chama Cha Uzalendo will be firm on its position of being a party that will engage and propagate civil descent politics; never will it engage in confrontational politics whereas, it shall not associate itself with any party or association that does not share in its aforementioned ideals.

GOOD GOVERNANCE.

Chama Cha Uzalendo and its presidential candidate will aspire to uphold ethics of good governance, transparency and accountability. The party shall respect the rule of law and shall instigate comprehensive reform of the public sector.

The party shall respect the principle of separation of power between the executive, the legislature and the judiciary, furthermore, given opportunity; the party shall empower each branch to discharge its responsibilities accordingly.

Chama Cha Uzalendo shall also strengthen the public service by weeding out inefficient service officers, dismantling unnecessary bureaucracy and duplication of duties. It will encourage creativity on the part of the civil officers and ensure that the officers have security of office and power to make decisions within their ranks along the laid down procedure in order to achieve performance expectations.

Hiring will be by credentials and not by prejudice, Chama Cha Uzalendo shall be in favour of job opportunities available in any area to have 60% share of opportunity accorded in favour of the locals.

Chama Cha Uzalendo will not only fight corruption but shall also go for an outright change of systems in its effort to streamline service delivery and the sealing of loopholes enabling pilferage. This shall be by instituting a Task force of the best patriotic sons and daughters of this country whose only mandate will be to study, investigate, recommend and recreate the best modes of service delivery for a sustainable period of time like twenty to thirty years. This will be in abid to save the country from irrelevant government expenditure on frequent changes of systems and the useless firing or frightening of service officers, which largely contributes to the poor morals in service delivery to the Kenyan people.



Chama Cha Uzalendo and its presidential candidate will device ways of motivating the Public Service Officers by offering training opportunities and revised remuneration so that the officers can be able to achieve high level of integrity and productivity, initiative, commitment and professionalism since the people of Kenya deserve and must get better service delivery.

Chama Cha Uzalendo is aware that, pay levels in the Public Service are a matter of concern and something really needs to be done. The party shall also focus on the remuneration of the officers under a long term strategy to improve pay levels and other benefits. These measures will reduce complaints, preempt unnecessary conflicts and industrial actions.

THE JUDICIARY.

The previous administration had perfected the culture of strangling the Judiciary by either planting judges and magistrates that are favourable to them or employing tactics of threat and intimidation in order to have their way. However, CCU will address this as a matter of urgency

and shall ensure that: (i) this becomes a thing of the past by introducing stringent measures in the process of hiring judges and magistrates and their promotion. (ii) the Judiciary enjoys precedent independence for it to be able to uphold and attain justice for all citizens of our country and other stakeholders. CCU shall (iii) take into consideration the recommendation of the Judiciary Service Review Commission, especially on the proposal of the establishment of a Supreme Court.

The existence of Commercial Courts has to a great extent eased the insemination of justice on matters to do with Trade and Commerce. Although there is still much that needs to be done especially on the acceleration of speed of case hearing and curtailing on the ridiculous awards that have come to be synonymous with the courts, especially when they are dwelling on who is who in the country.

Chama Cha Uzalendo will introduce a Land's Court which shall be mandated to deal with all land disputes, squatter problems and amorphous aspects of land ownership in Kenya. C.C.U. Will secure nullification of the house without land irregularity that is synonymous especially with the Coast Province. Chama Cha Uzalendo and its presidential candidate will also pay special attention to the need of expiration on courts premises with a focus on having a well designed court premise from, the Supreme Court, the High Court, Provincial and to the District levels countrywide.



ECONOMY.

Considering that our current economic status is poorly defined, CCU wishes to promise that, if enabled, the party shall pursue economic ideology that shall well be known and defined so that our country can attain economic stability. Currently, we have an amorphous model of capitalism which serves only the strong and the mighty to the detriment of the weak and the poor, creating a perfect situation of man eat man society.

Therefore, Chama Cha Uzalendo desires to carry out radical economic reforms that will be geared towards checking the increasing widening wealth gap that is leading us to a lot of stress and is getting us into social, political and economic instability. If we are to relate to the high rate of inflation, crime rate, rural-urban migration, low employment rate and poor remuneration. One should not consider voting back these con artists cum politicians and their schemes back to power.

Chama Cha Uzalendo and its presidential candidate will set measures to stomp out undefined increase in wealth gap, though not with an aim of taking away wealth from those who have it, but by encouraging those who are left out to join the bracket of the wealthy. Our reforms will also encourage Kenyans to be ambitious and productive in legitimate ways.

Chama Cha Uzalendo does agree and will uphold to adhere to the initiatives of free market policies that conform to a measure of regulation in order to protect and nurture our young economy, which is still by a large percentage; consumer based. The party does accommodate the policy of privatization of state owned or influenced co operations, but it shall never go too low into allowing the implementation of this policy to be for the benefit of foreign investors and their transnationals.

We in Chama Cha Uzalendo believe in Social Democracy and patriotism. Therefore, our manifestation of these traits shall not be evidenced only in politics but by greater extent in the economy where the Kenyan people should be at the backbone of the growing economy and this cannot be achieved unless by nationalizing some priorities that comes with privatization. A government that is bent on reducing Kenyans to workers only shall live to be our greatest enemy as our ideals dictate that Kenyans should engage more into entrepreneurship so that they may have control of the backbone of our country's economy.

Chama cha Uzalendo would like to go further by challenging professionals who have marketable knowledge and skills, to exploit opportunities where they are needed most unlike currently where it has become common to find graduates in agriculture, animal husbandry and fisheries looking for employment in urban areas hoping to work in an air conditioned office than in the fields where they have greater potentials.

Chama cha Uzalendo will motivate the professionals in their different categories such as agriculture, veterinary science, fisheries, engineering, to realise that in today's world of globalisation, they will not be competitive if they are not more aggressive and more innovative and if they do not unite and form stronger professionally managed indigenous companies and investments. C.C.U if it will be enabled to form the next government, will be there to empower them with start-ups initiatives.

Chama cha Uzalendo will focus a lot of its attention on the needs of our peasant farmers, including the small time fishermen, we will define ways of transforming the commonly taunted "jua kali" industry into a formal sector by encouraging the artisans with orders that shall instigate quality and growth of their products by providing the ready markets in form of government purchase.

For these initiatives to succeed, C.C.U will embark on a campaign to change the attitudes of Kenyans towards their own roles and the role of the government in a private sector led economy. Kenyans have to learn to be entrepreneurs and be ready to notice and exploit opportunities for

self-development so that economic reforms can provide the empowerment that is much short of.

Chama cha Uzalendo believes that a better life for everyone will not be brought about by the government going it alone. Furthermore, the government is just an institution that acts on our behalf and only on the capacity of enabling, but not giving as commonly perceived by most of us. A requirement of partnership between the people and the government must be there in order for the nation to achieve maximum benefits.

REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE.

Chama cha Uzalendo believes that, managing public finances is part of good governance. No efforts to improve governance and service delivery will succeed without better management of public finances. The previous administrations have only been making music of this issue considering that each has been good at accusing the other of public pilferage instead of actually showing its formula of how it does best its business, e.g. The Moi administration of 24 years was not spared due to the Goldenberg scandal amongst others, Kenyatta administration was very much on spot for reasons to do with land issues, but Kibaki has not been lucky either because, in by the GUN and out by the GUN, so in by “fitina” and shall be out by “fitina” since the dossier of Anglo-leasing was actually not a creation of N.A.R.C. but of K.A.N.U.

Unfortunately, the politicians in N.A.R.C. could not restrain themselves from the temptations of getting rich quickly. Since they had only changed courts but were actually members of the same school of thought.

Chama cha Uzalendo and its presidential candidate will set a break with the past by divorcing its administration from anything that has to do with wrongs committed by the other administrations. In fact it will consider amnesty to offenders in order to constitute a fresh start. It will harmonise all the institutions and commissions that had been mandated to investigate on this ills and will expect recommendations on case by case basis for granting of amnesty.

Chama cha Uzalendo strongly believes in amnesty as we pardoned the colonialist who stole so much from this country and our mother Africa including our labour which they got for free yet we have not lodged any reparations' claims for compensation like the Jews did, thus We should equally forget about this black colonialist who only took office not to

Chama cha Uzalendo believes in fiscal discipline and transparency as very critical to good governance and for macro-economic stability. The public finance Act, and the public procurement Act, must and will be adhered to and those who contravene these laws will not be spared. C.C.U government will embark on measures to curb reckless government expenditure on maintenance and repair of government fleet of vehicles by enabling the ministry of public works to perform this role.

REVENUE COLLECTION

Chama cha Uzalendo will not allow the national revenue collection targets to be achieved by ways of intimidation of the staff or impositions of unrealistic taxes on the citizens. All taxes, rents, licencing fees and penalties will be streamlined to be compatible with the realistic conditions of the country considering that the government is not a business entity to make money from the citizens who have devised its creation to serve them. Laws allowing government to expose by way of auctioning private goods if they are not seized by search institutions for any malpractice shall be abolished since the government's mandate is to collect taxes but not to do business or earn gainfully from the efforts of its citizens. The need to borrow from outside or inside by the government will be curtailed by widening the tax bracket, lowering the tax rate, and instilling efficiency on tax collection.



Chama cha Uzalendo will prioritise the most important undertakings that require the need for such assistance before getting the nation in more debt.

CCU GOVERNMENT will spearhead the restructuring of the revenue collection body K.R.A to reflect the provincial administrative structure so that each province can be able to get into terms with its true revenue capacity and how much is its input to the national revenue base in order to determine how much should be returned back and where the collections are low what should be done.

GOVERNMENT ROLE IN MARKET ECONOMY.

Chama cha Uzalendo wishes to promise that, once enabled, its role in good governance will be to entrench its responsibility of offering a market economy that is well elaborated and has a consistency in growth.

This can only be achieved by putting in force the following notable tasks.

- *A very conducive environment for local and foreign investments.
- *Streamlining government policy on licensing and elimination of red tape and bureaucracy including a one stop registration and licensing centre.
- *Facilitating strengthening of the rule of law and upgrading of the same to be compatible with current and foreseeable future demands.
- *Improvement of fiscal policies to encourage investment and production.
- *Enhancing the capacity to resolve business conflicts and disputes.
- *Enhance the labour laws and trade unions capacity to resolve industrial disputes.

MODERN, SUSTAINABLE AND FAST GROWING ECONOMY.

Chama cha Uzalendo and its presidential candidate if enabled, shall constitute a government that will transform the economy into a modern economy built on realistic principles that are well elaborate and functional; the Wild West principles of economic management will not be tolerated at all.

Principles that have not worked anywhere will not be welcomed, as we no longer have room for more experiments with our people who have had enough shares of problems. Principles that have worked are convenient to our interest and will be adopted and followed to the later.

Chama cha Uzalendo realises the need for a vibrant private sector. However, as its name goes, it has in its believe that an economy shall not be vibrant if at all there is none or it has just a marginal participation of the indigenous population.

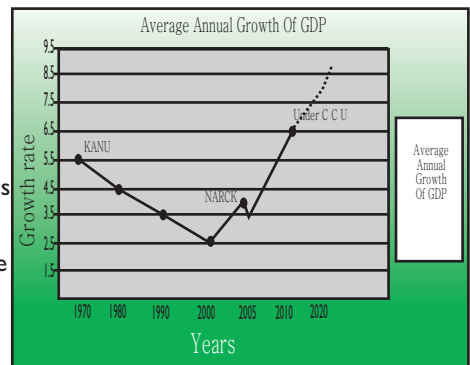

C.C.U will endure to ingratiate ourselves with such governments and institutions, but we will not hesitate to make decisions that meet the approval of such governments and institutions if we are convinced that such decisions have the people's interest secured since its us who bare the fatigue of voting thus the people's interests should be paramount.

After the economic debacle experienced during the 2nd and the 3rd phase government of economic mismanagement, C.C.U and its presidential candidate has promised that it will put in place very stringent measures by hiring the best trained and well motivated personnel to be in charge of our fiscal agenda. This shall start by giving the country the best minister of finance who will be mandated to put in place the extended restruktural policies that will instigate the National economic turn around towards prosperity.

C.C.U will do all these things since they are a pre condition for our rapid economic growth and for poverty reduction measures. However, we all should not ignore the realities of globalization which requires our entrance into the competitive regional and global markets. redress or accelerate development, but to celebrate their being in office with powers to do the same negative things the colonialists were doing on Kenyans.

AGRICULTURE

Chama cha Uzalendo believes that, Agriculture will for a foreseeable future remain to be the backbone of our economy since it is still the sector that provides the bulk of employment and sustenance of a vast majority of Kenyans. It is the sector that accounts for most of our commodity exports and industrial raw materials.

The previous governments have made attempts introducing subsidies and tax exemptions for fertilizers and agricultural tools, equipments and machinery, Chama cha Uzalendo will enhance this policy but with the ultimate aim of mechanizing indigenous agriculture for self sustenance in food production.

Chama cha Uzalendo and its presidential candidate shall also put in place a grand master plan that will be geared towards reclaiming barren land for agricultural use. This will be well founded and better staffed to quickly expand acreage under irrigation; this shall go along with the expansion of infrastructure to necessitate the availability of extension services and market support.

Chama cha Uzalendo will give prime importance to the livestock sector by devising ways that will see a transformation of the nomadic cattle herding way of life to a settled modern livestock keeping. C.C.U shall encourage the creation of ranches for the nomads in order to convert them to modern livestock keepers. C.C.U shall also embark on the campaign to dig boreholes in dry areas using the army and the youth service. Improvement of pastures, veterinary care, cattle dips and markets will be the prime undertaking.

Chama cha Uzalendo shall embark on developing better fishing laws to enable the local fishing industry to be at the centre stage of benefitting from the vast fishing resources in the country.

Resources in the sea and the lake will fully be harnessed by the C.C.U government through creating partnership with the communities within these areas with the aim of taking them off the ground to a level of self support.

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY.

We dream of a modern economy, but it entails the use of science and technology to achieve it. C.C.U will encourage and facilitate the greater use of science and technology which shall not cause any harm to our people.

C.C.U will also promote investment in science and technology, by developing a partnership with the private sector through which it will channel more resources to institutions dealing with the development and application of science and technology.

C.C.U shall establish a National fund for science and technology and will welcome contributions from stakeholders with the prime aim of tapping and developing skills in the Kenyan youth for the greater benefit of the country by involving them in efforts of reversing desertification and famine which is currently gripping the nation. Chama cha Uzalendo believes that, the area of Information Technology (I.T) has become a critical pillar of any modern economy.

I.T provides a good way to narrow the knowledge gap between developed and developing countries. Should CCU form the government, we shall exploit this technology to the later in streamlining government interlinks, accessibility of information, and delivery of service, be it in migration, persons registrations and agriculture where farmers will benefit with the most advanced information.

SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (S.M.E'S)

Chama cha Uzalendo understands that, all developed economies had their Genesis from agriculture to the industries then to the current and more advanced e based economies. C.C.U does believe that a similar transition beginning with small and medium based industries can take place here, and they have the capacity of producing jobs for easing the unemployment rate and stimulating economic growth.

C.C.U will facilitate the availability of credit via the National bank for the small and medium industrial based enterprises start ups which can absorb the locally produced raw materials for development to finished goods.

EMPLOYMENT AND INDUSTRIES.

Chama Cha Uzalendo and its presidential candidate before it promises Kenyans jobs as did the N.A.R.C party, will first take the honour of promising job security for those who are employed and greater rights in their working environments. C.C.U. Will overhaul the ministry of labour right down to the smallest job scale for a complete clean up. The labour laws will be upgraded to be compatible with the international acceptable standards.

Congestions in Urban areas

C.C.U will not out rightly hype the voters on the number of job opportunities the party government will create. However, the party does promise the generation of opportunities that shall enable en mass wealth and opportunity build up in the citizenry, like one witnessed in Dubai and the rest of Asian countries.

Chama cha Uzalendo has so far manifested its understanding and desire for growth in the industrial sector. However, the current make up of industries in Kenya leaves a lot to be desired. Chama cha Uzalendo knows very well that Kenyans need to be encouraged and supported to get into ownership of industries and that is what defines the economic strength of our country.

The idea of foreign investment and provision of labour from our past, shall not be accommodated as plainly as that. Better expectations and co-existence will be required so that, as we aim to be industrialized by 2020, our indigenouness should be visible in the economy.

CO-OPERATIVES.

Chama Cha Uzalendo believes that the best source of strength for the poor and the weak is unity. Cooperatives can give voice and power to the poor and the weak, structural reforms in the cooperative sector; a new cooperative policy and laws that provide a better environment in the revival of free cooperatives owned and run by the members themselves. C.C.U will encourage the formation of cooperatives where there are none and amongst the most vulnerable communities in Kenya.

EDUCATION.

Chama Cha Uzalendo and its presidential candidate understands education as a means of acquiring knowledge and skills. The goal of education is to transfer knowledge and skills from one to one or one to many with a possible high transfer rate under the possible shortest time to be used later in time or upon graduation. However, the previous administrations and political parties have totally failed to be elaborate on their goals on education; notorious being K.A.N.U which

introduced the 8.4.4 system then N.A.R.C and its free education policy which flew all requirements of quality in order to satisfy the demands of mass gratification while punishing those who struggle to meet their commitments.

C.C.U believes quality is paramount, therefore the only system that was proven to have developed Kenyans into super brains was the 7.4.2.3 system. During its time, the university was composed of fully prepared and highly matured students who were also instrumental in shaping the policy of the government, technical schools were flourishing with well trained students and polytechnics were raising up to offer the nation with the much needed expertise to spear head in the cramping for our industrialisation but when the system was changed, the nation immediately rot. Today, due to our poor training and poor levels of education, the immigration department has been involved in issuing work permits for tour guides and messengers from other countries , then what is left of ourselves if we cannot manage manual or just use of the mouth jobs in our own country?

C.C.U will introduce the 7.4.2.3 system along with the technical schools with an aim of absorbing technical minded students from form three level rather than allowing them to waste their time on learning things that might not be useful to them in life. A curriculum shall be developed to enable teachers to evaluate students alongside their talents and abilities.

The current education system measures competency with tests and assignments and then assigns each students a corresponding grade. The grade usually comes in the form of either a letter grade or a percentage with intentions to represent the amount of material presented in class that the students understood. C.C.U feels that this system lowers students' self confidence as students may receive poor marks due to factors outside their control including poverty, child abuse, prejudice or incompetent teachers.

C.C.U will encourage the teaching fraternity to research on this so as to work out a system that can raise self esteem of our students. C.C.U will also work on a programme which will ensure that every province has a National university, which shall have about 60% intake preference for students from the province.

C.C.U government will invest in text books and educational paraphernalia production via government owned agency, having noticed that education has been made very expensive by less human and unpatriotic Kenyans who wish to live in great luxuries at the expense of others, while their kids are taken abroad for studies. C.C.U asks, if your business is to sell books yet your children do not form part of the local students's fraternity, reasons being the inferiority levels of the educational system, then where do you get the moral authority to benefit from the same poor system?

C.C.U and its presidential candidate will accord the teachers great respect and honour if enabled. C.C.U government will not only ensure the terms and conditions of teachers are met, but will also demand quality service in the performance of students at all levels.

C.C.U will reign on the private sector schools to ensure that standards of high quality are maintained and cost of learning in these institutions is within the acceptable levels. The party will ensure that schools are established in premises and environments that are safe and conducive for learning. This will be upheld by the government inspectorate who shall be re-invigorated to give better watchdog service.

Religious institutions will be enabled to offer or participate in the effort of educating all Kenyans across the board.

C.C.U as a party will necessitate a nationwide inspection of all educational institutions in order to establish their viability in educational insemination. Quality will be high on the party agenda while focusing on working out a programme of improving and upgrading them to the required standards, instead of encouraging the construction of new ones when the existing ones are in shambles.

C.C.U will demand the teaching fraternity to improve the curriculum and quality of education as per the 7.4.2.3 system, in order to turn the current tide of students and parents opting to look for educational opportunities out of the country.

The proponents of the separation of state and religion will celebrate under a C.C.U government because we shall withdraw religion from the state curriculum and funding, Meanwhile, the mandate of religious propagation shall be left to the religious institutions to handle.

TRANSPORT

Chama cha Uzalendo and its presidential candidate is concerned with the high rate of deaths on our public roads systems. Certain measures will have to be put in place to reduce these levels and these include:

I. LAND

- *Expansion of roads.

- *Sealing of pot holes either by the local Authorities and the Ministry of Public Works.

- *All big trucks and buses travelling at night should be equipped with yellow sirens and have them on as they are making their journeys at night.

- *Mobile impromptu inspection units that will be empowered to arrest or seize the negligent driver's non regulations complying vehicles.

- *Age limit of drivers for public transport vehicles should be from 33 to 45 years only.

- *The traffic department will be elevated into a full independent police institution with its own director.

- *High standards of public transport vehicles to be recommended for design, size and quality including their service lifespan on the road which shall be minimized to two years.

- *Road Transport Department will be done away with as all vehicles will be registered at the point at which they are paying duty be it at the port, Airport, boarder points etc, while some functions will be assumed by the new traffic police.

- *The new traffic police will be in charge of motor vehicle inspection and shall stand responsible in the advent of any abnormalities.

- *New generation driving licence will be introduced and shall include columns for booking minor categorized offences that shall be penalized at the time of renewal to reduce pressure on the courts and corruption amongst law enforcement agency and the public; this will also define the status of the driver to sanction renewal.

- *The inspection unit will be upgraded as well as equipped with modern equipment for inspection, so as to attain high standards of vehicle's road worthiness in Kenya while placing environmental friendly policy in force. The 8 years limit for importation of vehicles will be withdrawn, but only cars and trucks passing the worthiness' test will be accepted in Kenya.

- *Massive initiatives will be carried out to decongest the Kenyan urban roads in order to bring down the amount of fuel and man hours wasted in these National jams.

*Construction of modest flyovers starting with the Uhuru highway to replace roundabouts followed by avenues in all other urban centers and the immediate commissioning of Dongo Kundu bypass to relax pressure on the ferry service operations.

Development of a modern frontier road project connecting Lamu, Garissa, Isiolo, Moyale, Lokichogio for ultimate aim of opening these frontiers to commerce while capitalizing on the emerging markets of south Sudan and Ethiopia.

2. MARINE

*Water Transport will be closely monitored with the same importance as land transport.

*Government encouragement and support for private investors on this sector will be fully available, especially on the dimensions of resuscitating the Indian Ocean and Lake Victoria trade.

*Port expansion measures in Lamu for cargo and Shimonzi for cruise will be accelerated in order to attract more traffic to our country, while aiming at achieving maximum benefits from the emerging markets in tourism and cargo industry.

*The Kenya ports authority privatisation program will be put on hold whereas expansion measures will be put in place immediately including the commissioning of the free zone project.

*Custom's procedures will be streamlined including revamping the state functions of revenue collection and creation of independent motor vehicle berth and clearance house at the car section and similarly to the container terminal to

necessitate in easy cargo handling and clearance.

*C.C.U will work and support the sea farers union to ensure that our country men and women are getting the best out of this industry.

3. AIR.

C.C.U as a party will identify itself with the current upgrading efforts of Airports in the country, but will not hesitate to veto the efforts should it find out that Kenyans are being cheated. However, C.C.U will place all efforts in contributing in any capacity to the face lift of these facilities and will also advocate for the exemplification of the African design and art in all our Airports to give the visitors a Kenyan African Welcome.



4. RAILWAY.

C.C.U does not buy into the idea of railway service privatization; In fact it finds people who hold into this idea as highly UN Patriotic.

Since our independence, the three governments' efforts on streamlining the Railway Service have been very negligible coupled with very poor handling of the staff. To privatize is to be unfair to ourselves. C.C.U does not wish to be part of this school of thought that believes in private ownership success and public service failure. It is a paradox that in many Kenyan institutions the notion on hold is that workers are failing to deliver when enjoying very many concessions while working either as civil servants or in state corporation's, but can perform and deliver well when they are poorly cared for when working for private firms.

It beats common sense to see the same person poorly remunerated delivering but not able to do so when he/she has such facilities as house allowances, health schemes and retirement benefits. After independence, our country has not extended one kilometre of the Railway line from the original construction of 1901 by the British East Africa Company. Therefore, C.C.U Government will work out on modalities of reversing this catastrophic trend by:-

- *Raising an itinerary of the current status of the cooperation.
- *Develop a stronger relation with the East African Networks.
- *Restructure the system of management, operations and remunerations of the workers.
- *Identify areas of expansion and creation of new networks with possible private participation.
- *Involvement of a private management company to run some aspects of the Service.
- *C.C.U Government will earmark land especially for use on this initiative so that we can connect our ports with new frontiers like South Sudan and Ethiopia.

WATER.

Dear citizens, water is the biggest problem for many Kenyans in both urban and rural areas. The previous government did their best by watching the dilapidation of the water infrastructure that was put in place by the colonial administration. They did not bother to upgrade the water supply systems to match the population growth demands. Therefore, C.C.U will make an effort to lay more kilometers of water pipes through the ministry of water, and shall not tolerate to see people residing besides the second world largest fresh water mass body Lake Victoria [sango] which covers an area of 67,850 sq km live without fresh drinking piped water just because of some archaic laws that were meant to secure good life for others in total disregard for us.

C.C.U shall reverse the privatization of water provisions services, since if the government cannot handle such noble obligation, Why should we then have a Minister of Water and a whole Ministry swallowing the public funds?

C.C.U believes that water is an item of National importance and should be high on the

National Security agenda. If the government cannot satisfy its citizens with their water needs, along with completely managing the water sources, supplies, security and distribution, then that government beats the logic of being in existence.

Therefore, C.C.U government will ensure that the water provision obligation remains a duty of the government and shall not allow its citizens to be open for exploitation by greedy people who assert that, 'under the government it can't work but under private ownership it works.' If there is such need for private participation, then they should be encouraged to develop their own infrastructure and equally be challenged to harness water from industrial sources with government partnership or introduce advanced technological equipment for desalination of sea water or recycling which will be bought by the government then supplied to the citizens...

C.C.U once enabled, will ensure that all the water sources and facilities are evaluated and determined on their worthiness, viability and ability to satisfy the current demands while putting on spot the health factors. The public will be well informed and involved in the process in order to attract a wide input of suggestions on the way forward.

C.C.U will constitute a team of engineers and consultants under the ministry of water to ensure that the input gathered as a result of this effort will be put in place immediately as long as it is viable and realistic and is not bent on exposing Kenyans on any negative factors.

C.C.U deplores the idea of allowing private water companies to benefit from a water supply infrastructure, that has been laid down by public funds. Their use and sale of water obtained from national natural sources is illegal and should not be allowed to thrive by any diligent government.

HEALTH IS WEALTH

Chama cha Uzalendo and its presidential candidate understands that for a Nation to be prosperous, its citizens must be healthy, and for them to be healthy, they need:

- *Accessible health facilities.
- *Well trained and patriotic medical personnel
- *Availability of drugs and related paraphernalia
- *Cost of treatments should be affordable and within realistic levels.

Chama cha Uzalendo believes that Kenyans have been taken for a ride for a long period of time. As a result, the party will set a radical change from the past considering that, most government businesses have been carried out in secrecy involving a lot of bureaucracy. C.C.U shall do business differently. An itinerary of all hospitals in the country shall be carried out with the objective of identifying their worthiness and viability so as to establish authentically what needs to be done, where, how and at what cost.

C.C.U will devise a less bureaucratic way of purchasing drugs and supplying them using provincial cords that shall be difficult to abuse.

C.C.U will also streamline the hiring of medical personnel, their enrolment and training using the same provincial codes which shall be even for all the provinces.

C.C.U shall streamline the activities of the National Hospital Insurance Fund (NHIF) of which up to date appears to be vague in its creation and service.

C.C.U shall curtail on flimsy clinics and hospitals and will also set limits on the cost of treatment in the country by adapting the Cuban and Indian version of Health Care Systems which have proven to be highly successful in these Third World countries. C.C.U will place a great importance in raising the ratio of doctors in Kenya with an aim of having one doctor for every ten persons by 2012.

HIV AND AIDS.

Chama cha uzalendo laments that, HIV and AIDS is the most serious threat to our National security after corruption and famine. The pandemic has adversely affected government delivery of service because it is disseminating the National human resource base. The scourge has seen the rise of many orphanages and NGO'S which have created room for abuse by some of their Directors who have smartened the language of philanthropy by exploiting the existence of this scourge for their own enrichment.

HIV and AIDS is transmitted sexually, and its breeding is necessitated by a particular environment which C.C.U shall work smartly for its destruction before going to the international organisations to ask for aids and grants for curbing the spread and also taking care of the affected.

SPECIAL GROUPS (DISABILITIES)

C.C.U believes that disability is not inability. we will put more emphasis in ensuring that people of disability and physically challenged are supported and developed in their various categories to ensure that they are at par with every other citizen in achieving their life long dreams. A special quota system will be established to make sure that their penetration and participation in the National Agenda is established and secured.

THE ELDERLY.

C.C.U and its presidential candidate wishes to honour the elderly as a national treasure since it's upon their existence that the importance of establishing a nation state was founded.

Therefore to reward and appreciate this, C.C.U will pass a legislation that requires all persons of 68 years and above to enjoy free access to all public facilities and service including free medical care on government hospitals, half the price in private hospitals and a tax free life.

We have seen the world becoming a better place with the efforts of such youthful leaders as Emperor Meiji of Japan in 1868 at 25 years, Joseph Kabila, (D.R.Congo) Bill Clinton, (U.S.A) Mahatir Mohammed (Malaysia) Queen Elizabeth (U.K) at 24 years but has lived up to the occasion and Nelson MANDELA of South Africa who sacrificed his youth for the cause of a nation.

C.C.U shall support the most competent and honest women leaders to be at the echelons of leadership. This will go along way not just to satisfy the desires of the gender crusaders, but also to manifest the importance of national involvement in decision making based on the principal that 'if women can vote, why not govern.' TOURISM.

Chama cha Uzalendo finds that the achievements in tourism are not enough to derive pride in Kenyan's abundant tourism endowments that include; wildlife sanctuaries, mountains and the beaches. Foreign investors have had a great encouragement but the effect has only resulted in 10% participation rate by the indigenous population. We need to change this by encouraging partnership so that full skills transfer in management and service provision can be obtained in order to accelerate the degree of poverty eradication, by instigating the entrepreneurial spirit on Kenyans other than on labour provisions.

Chama Cha Uzalendo will work together with people on the roads infrastructure to service the industry. The sector needs great transformation so that there can be an increase in the tourist arrivals and revenues.

Shimoni in South Coast offers the best natural site for a tourist cruise ship port. Its proximity to most hotels in the south, gives it a leverage for consideration in developing a cruise liner industry, instead of using the industrial port for the needs of a cruise industry. This will greatly open up South Coast tourism opportunities and the inter boarder business with Tanzania considering the proximity with Mount Kilimanjaro will grow to the good of our sister countries.

ENVIRONMENT AND CONSERVATION.

Chama Cha Uzalendo shall pay great attention to all initiatives of Enviromental Conservation. Man has only been good mostly at destroying what was placed to make his life bearable. There is need to reverse this trend, failure to which, the generations after us might find the most befitting description of us to be dinosaurs instead of human beings.

Where we have failed to protect the environment, the damage is obvious; erratic and low levels of rainfall, water resources drying up and areas getting affected by drought. C.C.U government will increase public education on environmental conservation and will enable the Ministry of Environment to accelerate the campaign for reversing this negativity.

C.C.U does not want and shall not tolerate people fighting pasture wars when infact they have not placed any effort to plant grass or trees in their surroundings to suffice their own needs. Instead, it shall encourage Community Participation in this endeavour, more for intent of stimulating greater responsibilities in pasture management.

C.C.U shall pay homage to the efforts of Nobel peace laureate; Professor Wangari Maathai with honours, while involving and adopting her research and recommendations as the National Policy on conservation.



Thirty years ago, there were in Kenya vast forests, fountains and streams and a large part of our country was still covered with grass, but today, things have changed drastically where as in some areas the situation is shocking. The National capital city was known as the “Green City in the sun”, but that is a bygone, well in the shelves of history. C.C.U asks, ‘if a car that has broken down can be repaired and achieve great performance, why can’t

our country be repaired or will we also need to privatise our politics? That is, if we cannot do it ourselves and are useless then do we need to hire Tony Blair, or Clinton to be our president? Then if it is so, what is the point of us being Kenyans?’

We cannot continue to be bystanders who are surprised at what is happening to our environment and to the life of our Nation. The freedom that is guaranteed to our citizens to live where they want in the country, should not be a license for them to destroy the environment;

CCU WILL ADOPT THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES AS A MEANS OF CONSERVING OUR ENVIRONMENT:

- 1) Every village shall be compelled to plant trees at their traditional water sources.
- 2) The Ministry of Roads and Public Works will be compelled to ensure that, where there are stunted trees, they are uprooted and fresh ones are planted along our main roads, avenues and near the bridges.
- 3) The Ministry of Roads and Public Works in conjunction with the Ministry of Environment, will create a mechanism that will facilitate the planting of trees and grass along the city and town road lines.
- 4) The Department of Mines will be compelled to develop a mechanism to monitor the environmental impact of mines, and ensure mining companies comply with established environmental standards.
- 5) The Ministry of Environment will propagate and participate in the planting of trees in areas with ample rainfall.
- 6) The Ministry of Environment will develop an environmental barometer and produce annual reports on the state of our environment, including success and challenges.
- 7) City, Municipals, and Town Councils will be compelled to implement fully the directive to plant trees in urban areas.

Chama Cha Uzalendo and its Presidential candidate will put urgent measures to protect the environment because the situation is deteriorating very first and affecting other sectors, such as the Nairobi River, which has deteriorated to alarming levels. The River Tana and its waters which have been harnessed to provide electricity to this country, the inhabitants of the basin have been left with nothing, the Yalla swamps which more often cause havoc on the humanity of the area, e.t.c

The water bodies like Lake Victoria which have been attacked by the water hycinth and other pollutants, need action to be taken to reverse this situation. C.C.U thus will encourage the creation of an East African Task Force that shall work on this problem with obligations of carrying out research, which shall be beneficial to the needs of the great lake countries.

SPORTS, CULTURE AND ENTERTAINMENT.

Sports is about pleasure and entertainment other than ancient idea of improving ones health, Sports is a way of life, Since sports has been known to make legends. It makes patriots, it unites, it never divides in spite of winners and losers, it makes love, it makes millionaires, it makes economies, it creates power, it builds nationalism. Therefore, this is one area that C.C.U leadership shall not at all take for granted.

The past leadership have deliberately ignored this field due to their old fashioned ideas which go along with considerations such as; its only in an office that one can earn a legitimate income, but the modern world has proved this nation wrong. We shall therefore do whatever it takes to make sure that Kenyans who envision dreams succeed through sports.



CCU acknowledges the passion that soccer has in this country. It is the game that has produced such greats like Joe kadenge, Kadir Farah, William Chege Ouma, J.J. Masiga, Bobby Ogola, William Obwaka, Willberforce Mulamba, Mahmoud Abbas, Abdala Shebe, Marshal Mulwa (Coach), Denis Oliech, Titus Mulama and many others. We wish we could have enough space to mention all of them but we salute them and are proud of them.

The patriotic citizens of our country have been diluted by the greed of individuals who have always turned out as soccer officials in clubs and football federations masquerading as enthused of the game but are only exploiters of the many good opportunities that come along with this game (politics and money); hence the never ending squabble in the management from the grass roots to the national level which actually is the cause of the current state of the game.

C.C.U and its Presidential candidate will ensure that tribalism, which has been the major factor derailing our prospects, is destroyed and bad characters in the management of sports departments and associations are gotten rid off.

C.C.U will empower sports associations to help ensure Kenyans become serious contenders of regional and international sports honors, with all citizens and stakeholders agreeing on a common policy for the future of sports in the country.

Our CULTURE is on the decline. It worries us very much especially with the pace at which it is deteriorating. Worse is total stagnation in most communities. There has been little or no effort at all in collecting and preserving cultural information, restoration, harmonization with the modern evolution for subsequent pass overs to the younger generation which has an over reliance on the western oriented media for culturalization.

C.C.U shall not, because of globalization, sit back and watch as the nation is being turned back by alien cultures. A protective measure shall be put in place and great emphasis on local developments shall be high on the agenda. C.C.U shall also work towards enacting protective laws that shall ensure artist rip proper benefits from their labor instead of being ripped off. Kiswahili is our national language. C.C.U feels that, the medium of communication at “sokoni” should also be the medium of communication at the banks and all other government institutions. C.C.U, will make it official alongside English in order to deny room for anybody who might wish to ignore another person simply because he/she cannot communicate in a foreign lingua franca which to some is assumed to be elite and upmarket.

This we believe is another form of prejudice and should not be tolerated. We also believe that since we solicit for votes in Kiswahili, then let the government offer its services in the national language too. The African union has agreed that Kiswahili should be one of the working languages of the organization. In the great lake regions, Kiswahili is increasingly being the lingua franca. Therefore, when these efforts are being put in place in other countries and institutions, we the inventors of this language and the host of the rich SWAHILI NATION are increasingly appearing to ignore the best of our own. C.C.U shall turn this around.

TOWN PLANNING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT.

Kenyans are not new to how some of its cities, municipalities and town authorities are ignoring town planning and urban zoning regulations. The following are points to note:

- Houses and parameter walls are blocking natural water courses.
- Houses are built on road reserves.
- Open spaces and playgrounds are being invaded.
- Domestic animals are kept in urban areas, close to other people's residences.
- High rise buildings are being built even in zones legally meant for single family dwellings.
- Residential houses are built on plots without the necessary infra structural services.
- Plots meant for public services, such as religious services, shopping complexes, social facilities, markets, schools, hospitals and the like are either invaded or decimated piece by piece for different purposes.
- There is too much litter, including plastic bags and open sewages.
- Construction standards are increasingly being ignored; a factor that is encouraging the mushrooming of substandard houses that are unfit for human habitation.

C.C.U believes that it is in every Kenyan understanding

that if this bend is not contained, our urban areas will become jungles of unplanned, unregulated and poorly serviced concrete structures. Therefore, C.C.U

government will ensure that the local authorities act immediately.

ROAD CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE.

The governments which have been in place have invested haphazardly on roads in the country without due regard to immediate necessity and its economic importance. Roads have been inflicted with the tribal cancer to warrant importance only where the big man comes from. C.C.U shall not be influenced by such cheap reasons, but will be dictated by the socio-economic needs of Kenyans by identifying immediate importance for agent attention until the whole country is connected within itself and the outside.

Cost and quality has been compromised in Kenya due to greed. Some Kenyans want to live in heaven while they are on earth, but not by working diligently but unscrupulously. C.C.U shall pass laws that will elevate such characters to National enemies status who will be prosecuted and sentenced to not less than 10 years in jail if found guilty and their properties seized by the state.

DISASTER AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

The C.C.U government shall establish the Ministry of Disaster and Emergency management; to take amongst others the duties of the special programs portfolio which shall be mandated with the obligation of establishing Emergency Rapid Response Mechanisms that will connect with special identified units in the Military, Police, Civil Sector and other stakeholders in case of emergency.

C.C.U Government will ensure that there is a standing response unit in all the provinces and a high alert mechanism in place to detect, respond to and coordinate the requirements of such an event.

The Ministry will develop the capacity for evaluation on magnitude of any occurrence and establish the requirements with lightning speed for easy movement of assistance in form of the right personnel and equipment.

The agenda will also be to develop local response units established purely for this and with the capacity and powers to deal with all other Government Institutions for ease of command and public briefing.

National Disaster

C.C.U does not wish to leave the work of saving Kenyan lives to foreigners as that is a sign of weakness in Nationhood. If an emergency befalls the Army Barracks or Headquarters', will we sit and wait for Israelis Soldiers from Tel Aviv to rescue our Army? If so, what's the point of maintaining Institutions that are only trained to destroy and not to build, recover or repair?

ENERGY.

Chama Cha Uzalendo will give priority to the expansion and improvement of energy supplies to both urban and rural areas in order to improve production and human welfare. Alternative sources of energy will also be in cooperated so as to ease the large dependency on hydroelectric power, having in mind the geothermal natural gas project.

C.C.U will also work on a formula to bring the power cost down by at least 40% as it also works on formulas for stabilizing power output and supplies.

The rural electricians program is an area that C.C.U will place utmost importance with considering that there is need to open up the rural environment, establishment of base for investment in small scale to medium size industries and business opportunities to reverse the rural-urban migration which currently is at an alarming level and becoming the major contributor to social instability in the urban centers.

C.C.U shall establish a rural electrification fund that will have targets and funds set aside in order to ensure the goals of rural electrification are attained first and with less bureaucracy within the shortest time possible.

C.C.U Government shall also prioritize the need to upgrade the Kenya Oil Refinery so that it can increase its output which we believe shall have an immediate impact on the economy by bringing the sourcing oil prices down to an economic viable level.

Oil is an essential commodity for any economic growth. Therefore, when this commodity is offered expensively in the local market, it ends up affecting the whole circle of our economic life, hence the need to regularize the industry and more so to subsidize the state NATIONAL OIL COOPERATION and its affiliate retail outlet NATIONAL so that it can be able to meet the country's National Retail needs. A measure we believe will place the Multi-Nationals under check and the Kenyan consumers at harmony with their standards of living in order to secure a sustained consistent growth through this sector.

FOREIGN AFFAIRS AND INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION.

Guard Of Honor

Chama cha uzalendo and its presidential candidate will radically shift from the tradition adopted by the previous governments of double standards on international relations. If

Kenya is a sovereign state in the name of THE REPUBLIC OF KENYA, then its foreign policies should reflect the same but not as currently where it largely played as if it is a province of another country.

C.C.U if enabled, shall adopt a policy of good neighbourliness with all its neighbours while at the same time shall participate fully in conflict resolution and where necessary, will offer its opinion and thought to accelerate a First hand integration of the international community.

Chama Cha Uzalendo shall also evaluate afresh the involvement of Kenya in international organisations and where it finds that Kenya's interest is not at stake, it will definitely pull out in order to relieve itself from the unnecessary burden of involvement.

Under C.C.U, Kenya shall continue to be a member of the African Union of which Kenya is a founder member and the United Nations. C.C.U will also pursue the agenda of adding more vigour to this organization with an ultimate aim of raising the profile of our country while showcasing the ability of her people. Under C.C.U, we shall offer the best hospitality to refugees in our country by demanding a decent registration. This will also offer opportunities for legitimate means to earn a decent living prior to their return. We shall not just cooperate but in fact demand that the international organization offering assistance do it as per international standards as we strive to achieve our share of the deal.

NATIONAL SECURITY.

Chama cha uzalendo and its presidential candidate does promise that, if enabled, matters of national security will receive very strict attention. We shall not at all allow others to make the country hell for their fellow citizens simply because they want to succeed via short cuts into great wealth or reap where they did not sow.

The C.C.U administration if enabled, will introduce a Ministry of National Security which shall be in charge of all institutions that relate to matters of security and protection.

Kenya is a beautiful country full of abundance and potential. However, instead of being exploited positively, it is being abused by powerful crooks that have masked themselves into leadership roles. This has generated reaction from the poor who for some reasons felt that the only way to get to the top is by way of crime, that's why in Kenya you find we are not at war with our neighbors and also not at peace with ourselves. C.C.U shall reverse this trend since we shall make sure that we are at great peace with ourselves and no enemy shall play around with us by adopting the following measures in our military and the police force:



Military Men

- Will work out modalities of having an East African force.
- Professionalize the activities of the army
- Convert the army into a rehabilitation center for petty and jobless offenders.
- When the country is not at war, the army should not be at peace since there is the war on hunger, poverty, poor infrastructure and the other National obligations. The army

should conscript more youths to be involved in this National agenda while acquiring skills of self development.

- Equipment and training will also be high on the agenda.
- Open up and devolve provincial wise the bidding and supplies process at the defence headquarters.
- Streamline the promotion of officers to be on merit not according to the intrigues of tribalism and nepotism.

THE POLICE FORCE.

•C.C.U shall Split the police force into; the Metropolis in charge of the cities; Nairobi, Kisumu, Mombasa, Nakuru and Eldoret with their own

Directors and County Police Department for the rest of the country.

- Introduction of the rank of inspector general to be in charge of all the commissioners and answerable to the government, although great autonomy and responsibilities for their offices.
- Training for urban warfare and introduction of guns that are easily handled and are flexible in city crime prevention measures.
- Training of the offices in public relations and public management techniques.
- Withdrawal of the G3 guns in urban areas.
- Re-designing of the traffic police.
- Raising the welfare and remuneration standards of the force in its new constitutions.
- Change the look of the force to reflect a force for a new independent nation, unlike today where it looks much more of a colonial relic with its attitudes towards the citizens it is supposed to serve.



TERRORISM AND REGISTRATION OF PERSONS.

Chama Cha Uzalendo will put in place the necessary measures to ensure that our territory does not become a place for sideshows Of other people's misunderstandings as well as we shall not use, encourage or assist the use of other people's territories for similar causes.

C.C.U shall not pass legislation that will appear geared towards putting Kenyan citizens in prisons within prison of their own country. However, this shall not be misconstrued to mean that we shall harbour criminal elements or allow their hibernation, but infact, we shall tighten

CONSTITUENCY DEVELOPMENT FUND (C.D.F)

Chama cha uzalendo does appreciate the effort placed by our colleagues on the need for taking the development agenda right on the hands of the people at the grass root level. However, C.C.U shall demand greater accountability of these funds, benefit projects activities earmarked in the provincial based policy guidelines and constituency priorities.



C.C.U shall assist in establishing a framework of guidelines on this initiative to ensure quality and worthiness of all the undertakings identified is achieved. Currently, there is a great conflict

Therefore the C.C.U Government shall engage experts to all the projects e.g. Schools, Clinics, Hospitals and shall have to meet a government engineer who will be in charge of quality management in the entire Districts in the whole of Kenya.

THE CONSTITUTION.

The constitution is a set of laws and agreements that are dependent upon for administering justice and fairness in a country.

Chama Cha Uzalendo and its Presidential candidate share the popular belief and agree that the current constitution is highly blotted and some of its aspects have been overtaken by time. As a result, it makes the work of governance via this constitution difficult to an extent that the principles of justice and fairness for all people are compromised.

In fact, it subjected Kenyans into an exercise that costed the tax payers over Ksh 10 billion. The other parties have made politics out of this issue, they also demand for a new constitution, but unfortunately, they will neither say nor agree on what should be in the constitution.

- The constitution making effort be attached to our 45 year Silver Jubilee instead of any election calendar program for the purpose of political polarization.
